The EMT Intermediate Technician program expands the role and skills of the EMT Basic. Students learn advanced skills involved in obtaining intravenous access, medication administration, and fluid therapy.

Prerequisites

- 1) Current licensure as an EMT-Basic in Wisconsin.
- 2) Completion of an EMT-Basic or refresher course within the past 24 months.
- 3) Current Basic Life Support Healthcare Provider certification.
- 4) Current endorsement of physician medical director.

Emergency Medical Services Program Outcomes

- 1) Assess requirements for emergency care.
- 2) Administer emergency medical care according to State of Wisconsin and National Registry standards.
- 3) Demonstrate proper patient transport techniques.
- 4) Demonstrate standard safety practices and procedures.
- 5) Demonstrate caring and respectful communication with all protective services personnel, hospital personnel, and patients.
- 6) Demonstrate general understanding of computer-based documentation systems.
- 7) Apply verbal and written communication skills.
- 8) Recognize the need for review, ongoing education, and maintenance of skills.
